#### CHARITABLE GIVING & SOCIAL JUSTICE — WHAT'S COMING UP

Early in August, Rev. Ilene will be meeting with a Social Justice Task Force. People selected to serve for this were recommended by Membership and Rev. Ian White Maher and then later, approved for the "ask" by Rev. Ilene Tompkins Gillispie. A Task Force is a group that works until completion on ... a single task. When the task is complete, the group is either dissolved or can be transformed by the minister (in this case, since it is a ministerial task force) into a ministry Team.

Agencies to receive charitable giving from UUTC Members and Friends during the 2017-2018 year are the Ministerial Discretionary Fund (July), Augustine Literacy Project (Aug.), Pisgah Legal Services (Sept.), Backpack Buddies (Oct.), UUSC (Nov.), "in kind" giving to Sharing House and the Community Christmas Dinner in December, The Haven (Jan.), Bread of Life (Feb.), S.A.F.E. (March), the Children's Center of Transylvania County (April), Muddy Sneakers (May) and Sharing House (June).

Our Congregation supports many other organizations through space use or donations of the "in kind" variety. UUTC Members & Friends volunteer with a number of different agencies, though our efforts are not coordinated in any formal way.

The Social Justice Task Force will be working on finding a new path forward for UUTC on Social Justice work that means more than charitable giving alone. The second half of our Mission statement—*To promote social, economic and environmental justice*— will be used by the Task Force as an intentional direction in considering its recommendations for how we might all better participate in the work of Social Justice in our community.

### CHARITABLE GIVING FOR JULY: MINISTERIAL DISCRETIONARY FUND

#### A Change in Execution

Starting this month, all Charitable Giving contributions will go into a separate fund prior to dispersal. **Therefore, checks should be written TO UUTC**, with the agency designation on the memo line.

This will allow your checks to clear almost immediately, making balancing your checkbook less of an issue. It also guarantees that you can deduct your contribution to the designated cause. UUTC will then write one check to the agency, or in this case, fund, and we will not have dozens of checks sitting around waiting for an agency to collect.

#### **Ministerial Discretionary Fund**

In the past year, our minister has given funds to help purchase medications, pay for



overnight housing, assist with utility bills and a few other needs. Sometimes these gifts support those at UUTC, and sometimes they support others in the community. Your gifts this month will refill this reservoir for Rev. Ilene to use in ministering to the needs of our personal and connected community.

This is an opportunity to give, not an obligation.

#### FIFTH SUNDAY COLLECTION

July is a month with FIVE Sundays, so UUTC will be collecting food for Sharing House at the end of the month. Baskets will be available in the lobby for your donations on July 23 and 30. Please take with you a list of most needed items from the basket on the counter.

The non-food items most needed by Sharing House are diapers, (sizes 5 and 6), laundry detergent, tampons (super), toilet paper, and paper towels. These items cannot be purchased with food stamps.

#### THE HAVEN NEEDS VOLUNTEERS

The Haven, Transylvania County's shelter for the homeless, is in great need for volunteers. This is an easy opportunity where you can enjoy a conversation with a resident or catch up on your reading. If you are interested in volunteering, you will receive an orientation so you can understand what is expected.
